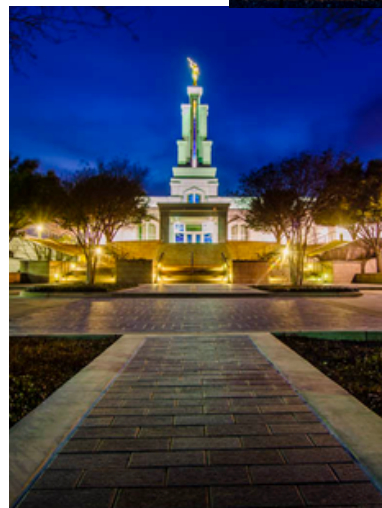
San Antonio Texas Temple
